96.2a Darambal See 'RLS' E16 (AIAS E46)

Darambal (AC, AIAS, SAW, O'G, 'RLS'), *Ta-rumbal* (R), *Darrumbal* (NH), *Yeppoon* ? (R)

Holmer (1972) found a Brisbane resident with a good working knowledge of the language who came from a north Keppel Island family.

96.2b Gonjmal See 'RLS' E32 (AIAS E49)

Gonjmal (AC, AIAS, SAW), *Koinjmal* (SAW alt. sp., O'G, 'RLS'), *Ra-ki-wa-ra* ? (R)

97-98. G. WIRADJURIC GROUP

a. *Main Wiradjuric** (O'G:Main) Subgroup

The members of this Subgroup (renamed *Main Wiradjuric* by Wurm) are similar to those of the 1966 classification except that *Geawegal*, 97.lb, (or *Gwiyagal*) is now classified as part of *Dharawal* - see 88.2c*, and *Barunggama*, 97.7, as part of *Waga-Waga* - see 94.lg*.

A noted characteristic of these languages is an unusual proliferation of tenses and specific time markers pinpointing action to specific time of day or night (as in *Tiwi*, 1). (SAW)
