

*Umonju, Umoriu* ('RLS'), *Wureidbug\** (Carroll, 38Nr. 'RLS')

Carroll is continuing to collect data from the few remaining speakers but nothing yet has been published. It is close to extinction. (Spelling changed in information supplied by Carroll).

### C. MARGIC GROUP

Also a prefixing but non-classifying group.

#### 5. Margu \*\*\* Croker Island (AC) N58 (AIAS N45)

*Margu* (AC, SAW, O'G, 'RLS', AIAS), *Yaako* (Windsor, Earl, Schmidt), *Ajokoot, Jaako, Marlgu, Terutong, Yako* (all 'RLS')

Major study still awaited of this almost extinct language to fill out Capell's earlier structural notes and vocabulary. SIL survey (1972) found only 4 speakers.

### D.\* GARIGIC\* GROUP

Classified in 'RLS' as a subgroup of *Yiwadja*, 2, but tentatively classified by Wurm, 1970, as forming a fourth group of the *Yiwadjan* Family.

#### 5A\*. Garig ? \*\*\* On mainland between Crocker Island and Cape Dow (Sch) (2, 54Nr.)

*Gari* ('RLS' 2), *Ga:rik, Garik* ('RLS' 54Nr., SAW), *Garig* ('RLS' 2, AIAS)

Schebeck's material all that is known and nothing has been published. Urgent need to expand the above and clarify the classification of this language.
