(The meaning as given in 'RLS' is incorrect - that meaning applies to *Budidjara*, 56.2b)

*Badimara* (AC, orig. AIAS), *Patimay* (WHD), *Patimaya*  
 (WHD, SAW)

Wurm tentatively classifies here and Douglas agrees with this classification.

- 52.4\* Widi Mullewa area (AC) A40 (AIAS A13)  
 (53.5b) *Cheangwa* (C), *Widi* (T, AC, AIAS, O'G, 'RLS'),  
*Witi* (WHD)

Douglas lists as a *Wadjari* dialect.

- 52.5\* Galamay 200 miles N.E. of AI2 (AIAS A4)  
 (55.2) Newcastle, W.A., Lake  
 Barlee area

*Galamai* (AC), *Galamay* (AIAS), *Kalamai* (von B),  
*Kalamay* (WHD), *Kalamaja* (von B), *Karlamay* (SAW),  
*Kelamai* (T), *Natingero* (C, Davidson), *Njindango*  
 (Herrmann), *Takalako* (?)

Originally listed by O'Grady et al as belonging to the *Mirninj* Subgroup but Douglas and Wurm now list as a dialect of *Wadjari*.

*Wardandi* (AC, AIAS), *Wardandee* (DB), *Kardagur* (C)

Deleted by all recent investigators. ]

54.1d\* Bibalman/Njungar Perth area W4 (AIAS W1)

*Bibalman* (AC, AIAS), *Bibbulmun* (DB), *Beebulmun* (DB),  
*Pibelmen* (O'G, 'RLS'), *Pi:belmen* (T), *Pipelman* (WHD)

Central Nyungar dialect agreed upon by all recent investigators.

54.1e\* Wirtimay ?

(53.5b)

*Wirtimay* (SAW, AIAS), *Witimay* ('RLS')

Listed in 'RLS' as *Witimay*, an alternate spelling for *Widi*, 53.5b. Wurm includes this name but it is not mentioned by Douglas or von Brandenstein.

54.1f\* Djabanmay Wubin, New Norcia area,  
and east to No. 1. Rabbit  
Proof Fence (WHD map)

*Djabanmay* (AIAS), *Tjapanmay* (SAW, WHD)

Mapped by Douglas 1967 and classified by Wurm 1970.  
One of the three dialect names for Perth Nyungar on  
Douglas' 1967 map.

54.2a\* Wudjari Doubtful Bay to W39 (AIAS W8)

(54-1)

Israelite Bay (DB)  
Around Esperance from  
at least Young River to  
Cape Arid, and north to  
Scadden (von B)

Means 'quickly running away' from *(w)udja* 'to run  
away' + *-(ng)arri* plural; not a Nyungar word but  
from *Ngadju* (von B)

von B), *Watjari* (WHD, SAW), *Warrangoo* (C), *Wanttandee*,
