Apart from a few songs recorded by Breen (1972) there is little apart from Capell's typescript vocabulary on this language. Speakers are reported to be fairly numerous, some at Wave Hill and Newry, but numbers not known. Has only 4% vocabulary overlap with *Malngin*.
