56.7\* Oodnadatta (Far Eastern) dialect

O'Grady-Klokeid link the three following dialects together with cognate densities of *Yangundjara* - *Andagirinja*, 90%, but only 64% with Warburton Ranges.

56.7a\* Andagirinja From Oodnadatta C4 (AIAS C5)  
 (56.2ad) west to the Everard Ranges (APE). Headwaters of Hamilton, Alberga, Wintinna and Lora Creeks, north to Erldunda, south to Stuart Range; at upper limits of Lilla Creek but not extending down to Finke River (AC)

Meaning not established except the suffix *-nja* is the proper noun suffix.

*Andagirinja* (AC, AIAS), *Andigerri* (Johnson & Cleland),  
*Andagarinja* (Hercus), *Antigerinya* (APE), *Antakirinja*  
 (T), *Antikirrinya* (Klokeid), *Antikiri* (WHD, Hercus),

 (Herrmann), *Antakerrinya* (Howitt)

Distinguishing characteristics:

'this' : *nyanga*

Klokeid collected *Antikirringya* Lexical Test List (1968?). Douglas has some unpublished texts and word lists. Hercus (1970) collected some data from Port Augusta. Rensch (1973) has started working on this dialect. Hercus thinks there are at least 100 speakers remaining living at Port Augusta and Indulkana Reserve.

'aboriginal man' : *wati* (WHD), *aṅangu* (O'G-K)

Douglas further comments that *aṅangu* (*arnangu*) is the usual Eastern "Western Desert" form for 'person'. It occurs as *yanangu* (*Yarnangu*) in the West (i.e. at Warburton Ranges through Mt. Margaret). In the event of death, it is possible that it could substitute for 'man', although it is unlikely it would substitute for 'initiated man', which would be either '*wati*' or '*puntu*' (WHD)

56.7b\* Gugadja (C.A.) Area bounded by Finke River in east to just south of where the Palmer River joins the Finke, north to Macdonnell Ranges, east to Cleland Hills and south to Lake Amadeus and Basedow Range (from T's map) AIAS C7

Means 'pertaining to meat' (*guga*), a name that distinguishes them from their *Aranda* and *Arabana* neighbours both of whom use *puntju* for 'meat' (WHD)

*Gugadja* (Platt, AIAS), *Gogoda* (O'G, RLS), *Kukata* (Berndt), *Kukatha* (Platt), *Kukatja* (T, O'G, SAW)

Distinguishing characteristics:

O'G-K estimate a vocabulary overlap with *Gugada* of 71%. (Also see comments below)
