

Holmer has collected a little fresh data from two informants ('72).

- 94.1d Ngoera E55 (AIAS E22)
Ngoera (AC, AIAS, SAW, O'G, 'RLS'), *Kiabara* (Howitt)
 Presumed extinct.
 'man' : *dthun* (C:167)
- 94.1e Waga-Waga Burnett Downs area (NH) E59 (AIAS E28)
 (also see 'RLS')
- Waga-Waga* (AIAS, PS), *Wakawaka* (O'G, 'RLS'), *Wagawaga* (AC, orig, AIAS), *Wakka Wakka* (NH), *Woka-Woka* (Hall), *Biloela* (dialect name)
- Holmer has gathered a reasonable amount of data in the Cherbourg - Brisbane area and hopes to be able to give a fairly full description of the language.
- 'man' : *mean* (C:159); *dthan*, *maree* (C:165)
- 94.1f* Wuli-Wuli * Dawson area (NH); Hawkwood Station, south of Mundubeera (Hall)
- Wuli-Wuli* (Hall, NH), *Wulili* (incorrectly spelt & listed in 'RLS' under *Waga-Waga*, 94.1e.)
- Hall (1970) and Holmer (1972) have gathered some remnants. The latter states it is preferable to consider *Wuli-Wuli* as an independent language, parallel to *Waga-Waga* within this group of languages.
- 'man' : *murrun* (Hall)
- 94.1g* Barunggama D7 (AIAS D40)
 (97.7)
- Barunggama* (AC, SAW, AIAS), *Barunggam* (O'G, 'RLS'), *Barrunggam* (NH), *Parrungoom* (Barlow)

Wurm queries O'Grady's classification of this dialect with the Miyan Wiradjuric Subgroup. Holmer classifies as being related to *Waga-waga* and *Wuli-wuli*.

'man' : *me-an* (Barlow); *garoon*, *booa* (C:l69)

95.1a* Djakunda E17 (AIAS E27)

No information except that Wurm still lists as a dialect of *Gurang-Gurang* (both listed by O'Grady in the previous subgroup).

95.1b* Gurang-Gurang Upper Burnett River E37 (AIAS E32)
(94.2b) (See also 'RLS')

Gurang-Gurang (AC, SAW, GB), *Gurenggureng* (C/S), *Korenggoreng* (O'G, 'RLS'), *Koreng-Koreng* (R), *Goreng-Goreng*, *Guring-Guring* (NH)

Holmer has managed to salvage enough for a description of this language. Breen has also collected a little.

95.2a* Dalla Sandgate - Nambour area E13 (AIAS E25)
(95.1a)

Dalla (AC, AIAS, SAW, O'G, 'RLS'), *Dala* (SAW alt. sp.)

Presumed extinct. Wurm retains classification here.

95.2b* Badjala Fraser or Great Sandy E2 (AIAS E30)
(95.1b) Island

Badjala (AC, AIAS, SAW), *Batjala* (NH, O'G, 'RLS'), *Badyala* (NH, PS, Hall - name of people); *Dipple* (dialect name - Hall)

Hall collected a little and also Holmer and he is including early manuscript material also.

'man' : *guri* (Hall); *than* (C:l64d)
