In 1970 Breen recorded a little of the Rolleston language which his informant called *wadjigu* which Breen originally thought might be another name for Capell's *Garingbal*. However subsequent enquiries have revealed it cannot be identified with any other language name. It is a related dialect to *Bidjara*.
