

- 4Kr. Waladjangari K15 (AIAS K24)  
See No. 46.3d\*.
- 5Kr. Bemba Deleted  
Vaszolyi says it is a *Gunin* place name *Bembar* denoting area round King Edward River via Barton River up to King George River which used to be the horde land or tribal territory of the *Gunin* people. Capell says it is definitely not a language name but a compass point, (*bembar*).
- 6Kr. Mariung K14 (AIAS K38)  
No information.
- 7Kr. Wulu Deleted. (AIAS K43)  
Probably mistaken for *wula*: which means 'language' in Eastern *Ngarinjin*; (*wulan wungarinjin* means 'Ngarinjin language') (AC)
- 8Kr. Jeidji K8 (AIAS K32)  
Means 'talk, speech' (SIL)  
Is part of *wunambal*, 48.1a\*
- 9Kr. Manungu K8 (AIAS K46)  
Means 'hill country' (SIL). It is a local division of the Forrest River. Capell has some material which shows slight dialectal changes.
- 10Kr. Walar K8 (AIAS K45)  
Part of *Ngarinjin*; see 46.3c\*.
- 11Kr. Wembria K8 (AIAS K31)  
(deleted)  
Possibly a territorial name. (SIL)
