Breen has been collecting data and believes he has all that is now available (several hours recording comprising 200-300 words and basic grammatical material). It shares 74% common vocabulary with *Garuwali*.

In 1970 and 1971 Breen made further recordings at Birdsville. A little more may be possibly salvaged from a remaining informant. Corpus now tallies several hours and 200-300 words. It shares a common vocabulary with *Yandruwanda* of 75%.

Breen has recorded about 30 hours 1970-73 from two knowledgeable informants. He now has more than 1,400 words recorded.
