

125.3f\* Golumala \*\* Territory known as  
*Gulka?wuy* east of  
*Dadiwuy* country (KQ)

*Golumala* (Sc); (incorrectly listed in 'RLS' as an alt.  
name for *Gujala*, AIAS N109, 'RLS' 5NAr.)

Has the same dreaming as *Marangu* and belongs to *Dhuwa*  
moiety. It is spoken by c. 60 people now mostly  
living on *Elcho Island*.

The above five form the western edge of the dialect.

125.4\*. d. *Dhiyakuy* Sub-subgroup\*

language of the *Yulngu* Subgroup.

125.4b\* Wagilag \*\* Rose River area (KQ) (AIAS N106)

37NAr.), *wagilak* (Sc)

*Dhuwa* moiety.

125.4c\* Manggurra \*\* Lower *Durabudboi River*
