Mararba (AC, AIAS, SAW, O'G, 'RLS'), *Madarrpa* (Sc)

Capell recorded 600 words and Schebeck has recorded. Is the southern dialect which Schebeck calls Ngi?ngi Subgroup.

125.2* b. *Dhuwal* Sub-subgroup*

Wurm lists only two members in this section, *Djambarrbuyngu* and *Djabu*. The other six names are given by Schebeck. All belong to the *Dhuwa* moiety.

125.2a* Djambarrbuyngu ** Inglis Island, both' (AIAS N115)
(2NAr.) sides of Buckingham
(15NAr.) Bay, Napier Peninsula,
(76NAr.) Kurala and Gopalpa
Rivers (KQ)

Djambarbwingu (AC, AIAS, SAW alt. sp.), *Djambarbutngu* (SAW), *Djambarrbuyngu* (Sc); also the following *mala* are associated with *Djambarbwingu*: *Gujula* (AC, AIAS N109, 'RLS' 5NAr.), *Guyula* (Sc, KQ - Gopalpa River area south of Buckingham Bay); *Durulji* (AC, AIAS N122, 'RLS' 15NAr.), *Dhurili* (KQ - Kurala River area); *Ralwia* (AIAS N116W, 'RLS' 76NAr. - described as a *Guyala mala* - KQ)

Djabarbwingu has a shared vocabulary with *Datiwuy* of 62% and with *Dalwangu* of 58%.

125.2b* Leyagawumirr ** Southern tip of Elcho (AIAS N101)
(21NAr.) Island (KQ)

Leyagawumirr (Sc), *Liagojomir* (AC, AIAS, 'RLS' 21NAr.)

125.2c* Layagalawumirr At Mirarrmina Creek (AIAS N108)
(22NAr.) (KQ)

Layagalawumirr (Sc), *Liagalawumiri* (AC, AIAS, 'RLS' 22NAr.)

The above three form the western edge of the subgroup.
