*Djambarbwingu* (AC, AIAS, SAW alt. sp.), *Djambarbutngu* (SAW), *Djambarrbuynngu* (Sc); also the following *mala* are associated with *Djambarbwingu*: *Gujula* (AC, AIAS N109, 'RLS' 5NAr.), *Guyula* (Sc, KQ - Gopalpa River area south of Buckingham Bay); *Durulji* (AC, AIAS N122, 'RLS' 15NAr.), *Dhurili* (KQ - Kurala River area); *Ralwia* (AIAS N116W, 'RLS' 76NAr. - described as a *Guyala mala* - KQ)

*Djabarbwingu* has a shared vocabulary with *Datiwuy* of 62% and with *Dalwangu* of 58%.

125.2b\* Leyagawumirr \*\* Southern tip of Elcho (AIAS N101)  
(21NAr.) Island (KQ)

*Leyagawumirr* (Sc), *Liagojomir* (AC, AIAS, 'RLS' 21NAr.)

125.2c\* Layagalawumirr At Mirarrmina Creek (AIAS N108)  
(22NAr.) (KQ)

*Layagalawumirr* (Sc), *Liagalawumiri* (AC, AIAS, 'RLS' 22NAr.)
