- 87Yr. *Ug'windjila* Possibly *Agu Windjila*, if so, a term for Central Paman speakers used by the *Rarmul*(?) (BAS)
- 88Yr. *Waigur* Sommer has found no source for this name on the field or in the literature
- 89Yr. *Wal'boram* No fresh information
- 90Yr. *Walmbarddha* Mis-identification in 'RLS'. See 109*, and 33Yr.
- 91Yr. *Wulbudji'bur* Nothing further
- 92Yr. *Di:ru* See 111.1 'RLS'
- 93Yr. *Narungu* Not listed in this revision. Comment it belongs with the Yara Subgroup unconfirmed

- 9NAr. *Dai, Dhayi* Deleted N118
 Not a language name. Means 'green ants'. Probably confused with *Dha'i*, a group name taken from a dialectal word for 'that' (see 128*.) Or it may be

confused with a linguistic group, the *Deyi* mentioned by Shapiro. (No. NI18 is therefore deleted).

- 10NAr. *Dajoror* See 123.1a*
- 11NAr. *Darmarmiri* Deleted N124
Probably not a language name. The closest the informant came to recognising this name was the word *djamamirr* 'working man'. (No. NI24 deleted)
- 12NAr. *Dijogoi* Deleted N149
Correct spelling is *Dhiyakuy* which means 'that place'. (No. NI49 deleted)
- 13NAr. *Djarlwa:g* See 128a*
- 14NAr. *Djarn* Deleted N143
Probably not a language name. It is possibly a shortened form of *djarndjarn* 'dhun a word relating to the carrying of food.
- 15NAr. *Durilji* See 124.1a*
- 16NAr. *Galwangug* See 124.1c*
- 17NAr. *Gigi* See 123.2b*
- 18NAr. *Gulunggor* Deleted N105 N105
Closest word recognised was *gulnggu* which means 'witch doctor'. (No. NI05 deleted)

- 20NAr. *Lamami* See 125.1b*
- 21NAr. *Liagojomir* See 124.1b*
- 22NAr. *Liagalawumiri* See 124.1c*

Probably *Nundjurrpi*, a *mala* of one of the languages. (*Mandalpue* deleted as an alternative name; is the same as *Mandelbui*, 32NAr. and is probably another *mala*.)

Dialect of *Djinba* (Wood)
