

*Lamumiri* (AC, AIAS), *Lamami* (Sc, 'RLS' 20NAr.)

*Yirritja* moiety. The above two dialects constitute the eastern dialect which Schebeck calls *Ngatang'-thundami*.

- 125.3c\* Galbu \*\* North-west side of (AIAS NI39)  
(112.2b) Caledon Bay known  
as *Garulwuy* (KQ)

*Galbu* (AC, AIAS, 'RLS', SAW), *Galpu* (Sc)

Most people speaking this dialect (c. 160) live on Elcho Island. It has most lexical items in common with *Wan?guri*, 59%, *Djambarbuyngu*, 49% and *Waramiri*, c. 70%; there are strong social links with the latter group.

- 125.3d\* Ngayimil \*\* Round Peter John River (AIAS NI39)  
(27NAr.) near Gove Airport, known  
as *Wurrulala*

*Ngayimil* (Sc, AIAS), *Ngaymil* (LMW), *Njawmil* (Sc),  
*Ngeimil* (AIAS 116X, 'RLS' 27NAr.), *Ngaymil* (KQ)

*Dhuwa* moiety. Schebeck recorded and West recorded some songs relating to the *broлга*.

- 125.3e\* Wan?guri \*\* Cato River area, east (AIAS NI34)  
(112.4) side of Arnhem Bay,  
(50NAr.) called *Dalingbuy* (KQ)  
(69NAr.)

*Wan?guri* (AC, AIAS, O'G, 'RLS'), *Wangurri* (Sc),  
*Wan'gurri* (RW); *Lul?marangu* (AC, AIAS NI10, 'RLS'  
50NAr. - means 'base of a tree' - a *Wan?guri*-speaking  
*mala* from Ramungir Bay who are *Dhuwa* moiety and have  
the one dreaming with *Maragulu & Marangu* - KQ);  
*Mandjgai* (AIAS 116P), *Mandjigai* ('RLS' 69NAr. - a  
*Wan?guri* term for group of clans from Dhalingur to  
Howard Island and from Milingimbi to Bunbuwa - KQ)

*Yirritja* moiety. At least 100 speakers remain on Elcho Island.
