

125.3f* Golumala ** Territory known as
Gulka?wuy east of
Dadiwuy country (KQ)

Golumala (Sc); (incorrectly listed in 'RLS' as an alt. name for *Gujala*, AIAS N109, 'RLS' 5NAr.)

Has the same dreaming as *Marangu* and belongs to *Dhuwa* moiety. It is spoken by c. 60 people now mostly living on *Elcho* Island.

The above five form the western edge of the dialect.

125.4*. d. *Dhiyakuy* Sub-subgroup*

Wurm lists the following three dialects as the fourth language of the *Yulngu* Subgroup.

125.4b* Wagilag ** Rose River area (KQ) (AIAS N106)
 (37NAr.)

Wagilag (SAW, AIAS), *Wagelag* (AC, orig. AIAS, 'RLS' 37NAr.), *Wagilak* (Sc)

Dhuwa moiety.

125.4c* Manggurra ** Lower *Durabudboi* River
 (70NAr.) near *Blue Mud Bay* (KQ)

Manggurra (Sc, 'RLS' 70NAr.), *Manggura* (SAW)

Dhuwa moiety.
